



BRISBANE STATE HIGH SCHOOL MASTER IN CHARGE/TEACHER: GIRLS' ROWING

The MIC position is available for registered teachers who will teach a combination of any of the following subjects:

- Mathematics A, B and C (Years 11 and 12)
- Science (Years 8 to 10)

This is a permanent teaching position.

Masters in Charge are responsible for:

- The overall organisation of the sport within the school
- The ongoing development of the sport

The MIC position requires:

- Full registration or eligibility for full registration as a teacher in Queensland
- A very good knowledge of rugby union / rowing
- High level organisational capacity
- Demonstrated excellent communication skills
- An understanding or capacity to develop an understanding of the unique Brisbane State High School context.

Applicants should describe their suitability in relation to the above requirements on a maximum of two A4 pages.

Applicants who are not currently registered with Education Queensland are required to complete a Teacher Application Package and send it to the Teacher Applicant Centre, PO Box 469, Ipswich Qld 4305.
