# 5. Adoption of Audited Financial Statements for the year ending 31 December 2008

The CEO reported Rowing Queensland Inc is in a sound financial position.

Revenues from Ordinary Activities returned a \$9,770 profit in 2008.

Overall, income revenue increased from 2007 to 2008. Factors impacting here included increased revenue from Grants primarily the Department of Sport and Recreations 2008-10 organisational funding allocations and various one off grants for development and High performance initiatives. Income from State



Team contributions has been reduced by RQI in order to reduce levies placed on athletes representing Queensland.

With regards to operating expenses, three significant increases require comment. The Revaluation / Loss component has decreased significantly from 2007 to 2008. The increases in Administration and Employment expenditure is related to the growth of the administrational capacity of the Rowing Queensland Office from the employment of a High Performance Manager and Education and Safety Officer. These activities are offset by the resulting increase in revenue derived from these activities.
